Description of Works

The works were to carry out the infrastructure construction to the former Dinnington colliery; the site covers approximately 2 hectares.

A substantial aspect of the works was to carry out the installation of a flood alleviation system to reduce the risk of flooding on the site in the future.

The works essentially comprised the following elements of construction:

- Earth works to cut the site to the required formation level
- Construction of approximately 1000m of flood alleviation ditches
- Lining of flood alleviation ditches with fabric liner topped with clay based material
- Construction of 1200m of roads with all associated aspects and drainage network
- Construction of several RC drainage outfalls
- Construction of bridleway network around site with shrubbery and associated gates and fencing
- Soft Landscaping to the remaining areas with plants, shrubs and grassed areas.

The works were successfully completed within the required timescale and within budget.
