Improving a busy junction without disruption to traffic or community

Client: East Riding of Yorkshire Council

Location: South Cave

Contract Value: £437,000 (Framework)

Contract period: 17 Weeks

The busy South Cave junction with the A63 had in recent years seen even higher volumes of traffic. As a result of its proximity to the A63, during peak traffic flows, slow moving and stationary vehicles were backing up the A63 dual carriageway.

As part of our framework with ERYC, we were engaged to construct a new roundabout on the line of the existing junction.

As is the case with most highway improvement schemes the construction itself was the simplest part of the contract. The challenges were to maintain traffic flows along the road, access to the adjacent 24-hour service station and to a 50-acre caravan storage depot.



We completed this complex operation with a zero complaint level and were complimented by local residents and businesses for our works planning which was phased and arranged to maintain flow and access at all times.
